 - Skills: cutting, gluing, planning compositions

- Painting (3 to 4 projects)
 - Skills: watercolor and tempera, acrylic, verbal presentation, various painting techniques, color mixing

- 3 Dimensional Art (2 to 3 projects)
 - o Skills: Clay work (additive and subtractive), sculpting, found object
 - o Concepts: positive/negative space, symbolism, texture, form, balance
 - Artist/time period/ theme: Brancusi, Bernini, Rauschenberg, Picasso
